# Checking/Cleaning A Drain Valve

**Step 1 – Shut off BOTH water supplies**

**Step 2 – Remove lower service panel**

**Step 3 – Remove drain hose.**

- Using a 5/16 socket and ratchet loosen hose clamp to remove drain hose from the drain valve assembly.
- Once hose is removed the valve should be in an open position, allowing you to see thru the valve.
- Inspect valve for obstructions or build up of foreign material

**Step 4 – Checking the drain valve.**

- Start the washer cycle, In doing this the signal should be sent to close the valve to fill the cylinder.
- You will be able to view the ball valve close when the cycle starts.
- If valve fails to fully close, check for obstructions or faulty drain valve. Replace drain valve if necessary.
